Queensland Representative School Sport Implementation Working Group (QRSS-IWG)

Purpose

The Queensland Representative School Sport – Implementation Working Group (QRSS-IWG) has been established to provide advice to the Queensland Representative School Sport – Board (QRSS-B) and the Assistant Director-General, Disability, Inclusion and Student Services to the lead the implementation of the 2020 Queensland Representative School Sport Review recommendations.

Guiding principles



Performance-based outcomes

Create safe, affordable and equitable representative school sport pathways with an unrelenting focus on excellence, engagement and wellbeing for staff and students. Monitor the performance, efficiency and effectiveness of the representative school sport program.



Evidence-based

Provide evidence based recommendations to support and guide strategic direction and ensure alignment of decision-making processes across the statewide program.



Fit-for-purpose

Create inclusive and equitable opportunities and access for all Queensland students at all levels of representative school sport, being responsive to community needs and departmental priorities.



Trust and transparency

Establish clear and transparent governance arrangements, support entities to make impartial and ethical decisions that uphold human rights, promote confidence, demonstrate accountability, and withstand legal and public scrutiny of the representative school sport program.



Risk-based

Make recommendations for representative school sport that balance opportunity and risk to achieve the strategic priorities and objectives for Queensland Representative School Sport.



Responsibilities

- provide a platform for collaborative consultation and strategic thinking in relation to Queensland
 Representative School Sport's (QRSS) improvement agenda;
- provide expert advice, recommendations and proposals to the QRSS-B and Assistant Director General, Disability, Inclusion and Student Services to support the implementation of improvement activities arising from the 2020 review of Queensland School Sport;
- provide expert insight on the feasibility of review recommendations and improvement initiatives;
- lead the development and implementation of the Queensland Representative School Sport Implementation Plan 2021–23;
- provide a forum for the Department and key stakeholders to discuss emerging issues and strategies to resolve issues as they arise during implementation of the Queensland Representative School Sport Implementation Plan 2021–23;
- identify the resource implications, policy and administrative changes that will be required as a result of implementing the Queensland Representative School Sport Implementation Plan 2021– 23;
- develop effective communication to drive implementation of policy and administrative changes across regions, schools, stakeholders and business units;
- · consider human rights in all actions and decision making; and
- escalate issues to the QRSS-B or delegated authority as appropriate.

Subordinate groups


QRSS - Sport Executive Implementation Working Group
