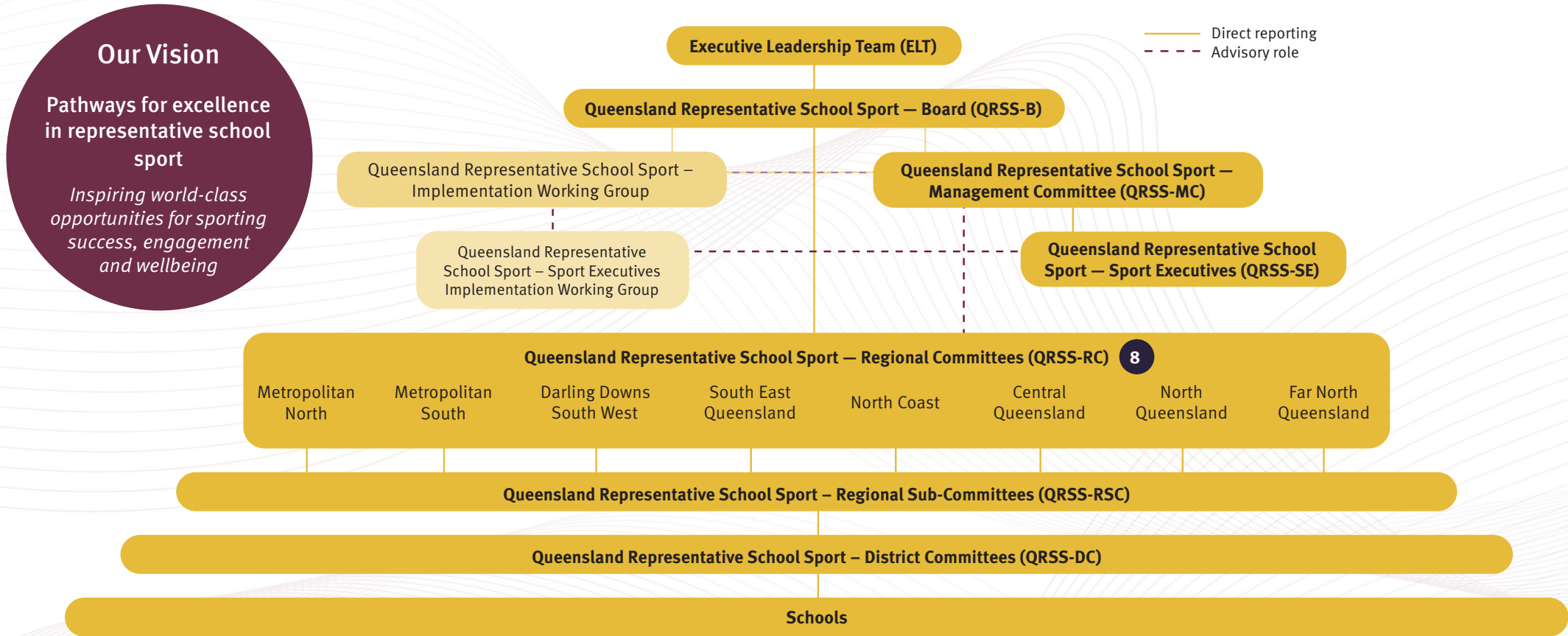


# Queensland Representative School Sport governance model



## Our Purpose

- Enable safe, affordable and equitable representative school sport pathways in all Queensland schools with an unrelenting focus on excellence, engagement and wellbeing for students and staff.
- Provide opportunities for students and staff to develop the capabilities of leadership, resilience, teamwork, sense of fair play and sportsmanship on and off the field.
- Lead the delivery of district, regional, state, national and international events and championships in a diverse range of individual and team sports for Queensland school students.
- Provide accessible and relevant professional learning opportunities for staff to develop their capability to lead representative school sport.
- Build and maintain sustainable community partnerships, leveraging skills and resources which complement and enhance our representative school sport programs.

# Queensland Representative School Sport governance model

## Queensland Representative School Sport – Board (QRSS-B)

The QRSS-B is the governing body that leads the strategic development and administration of the Queensland Representative School Sport (QRSS) program. The Board endorses, approves and directs all activities of the Queensland Representative School Sport – Regional Committees (QRSS-RC), reviews and approves the endorsed recommendations of the Queensland Representative School Sport – Management Committee (QRSS-MC).

## Queensland Representative School Sport – Management Committee (QRSS-MC)

The QRSS-MC manages and implements the day-to-day operations of representative school sport competition across Queensland. The Management Committee endorses and, where relevant, approves, directs or advises the activities of the Queensland Representative School Sport – Sport Committees (QRSS-SC).

## Queensland Representative School Sport – Sport Executives (QRSS-SE)

The QRSS-SE provide, foster and develop sport within state schools, non-state schools and other educational institutions affiliated with QRSS. The Sport Executives exercise the general control and management of operational matters for each sport that form part of the QRSS program. Each Sport Executive ensures inclusive and equitable opportunities and pathways that are accessible for all students at all levels of representative sport.

## Queensland Representative School Sport – Regional Committees (QRSS-RC)

The QRSS-RC are the governing bodies that lead the strategic development and administration of the QRSS program within each region. The QRSS-RC endorse, approve and direct all activities within the Sport Regions and District Committees.

## Queensland Representative School Sport – Regional Sub-Committees (QRSS-RSC)

The QRSS-RSC are an advisory body that may be established to provide, foster and develop sport within a Sport Region. The QRSS-RSC provide direction to ensure alignment of the representative school sport program across districts within a Sport Region. QRSS-RSC are established at the discretion of Regional Committees.

## Queensland Representative School Sport – District Committees (QRSS-DC)

The QRSS-DC provide, foster and develop sport within affiliated schools in each district. The QRSS-DC exercise the general control and management of operational matters of district events and progress district specific issues to the QRSS-RC as required.

## Queensland Representative School Sport – Implementation Working Group

The Implementation Working Group leads the implementation of the QRSS Review agenda. The working group provides expert insight on the feasibility of the review recommendations and improvement initiatives and presents recommendations to the QRSS-B. Additionally, this group provides advice and direction to the Sport Executives Implementation Working Group.

## Queensland Representative School Sport – Sport Executives Implementation Working Group

The QRSS – Sport Executives Implementation Working Group provides direction and guidance to the QRSS-SE regarding the implementation of the QRSS Review recommendations. The working group provides a forum for key stakeholders to discuss emerging issues and strategies as they arise during the implementation of Sport Executives.
